The workshop will cover the following elements:

- Parts of the hearing aid
- Checking hearing aids are working
- Checking the batteries and changing them
- Checking that the hearing aids are in the correct ear
- Checking moulds are fitted properly and to recognise when they are damaged
- Changing tubing
- Troubleshooting the radio aid (FM system)
- What to do when problems can't be resolved
- Who to contact for advice and support
