

Accessibility plan

Schools need to ensure that they have an **accessibility plan** and review it in light of the changes to the <https://thehub.walthamforest.gov.uk/support-services/sen> system. The plan can be a freestanding document, or it can be incorporated within another plan, such as an equality plan.

A school's **accessibility plan** should be reviewed at least every three years. The governing body is free to delegate approval of the plan to a committee of the governing body, an individual governor or the head teacher. The requirement for an accessibility plan is driven by the [Equality Act 2010](#) and the [Disability Discrimination \(Prescribed Times and Periods for Accessibility Strategies and Plans for Schools\) \(England\) Regulations 2005](#).
